



2018 Executive Board Nomination Petition Information

The Executive Board manages the business affairs of MAPE. It hires the Executive Director, determines all expenditures of funds, authorizes concerted activities and determines the necessity or desirability to file lawsuits on behalf of the Union. The Executive Board is empowered to take action that may be necessary to further the goals and objectives of the Union.

In order to be nominated, a MAPE member, in good standing for at least one year, must submit a completed Executive Board Nomination Petition with *at least* 10 qualified member signatures, to the MAPE offices at 16 Mitchell Blvd, San Rafael. Extra signatures are recommended. **Completed petitions must be received by the Union by 5:30PM on Monday, November 6, 2017.**

The candidate may submit a statement of up to 200 words with the petition, to be distributed with the ballots to all Union members eligible to vote for the position.

The Executive Board has one meeting a month at the MAPE office. The regular meeting date is the third Thursday of the month. This meeting lasts about 2 hours and starts at 5:30PM. Dinner is provided. Board members are required to attend MAPE Steward training and Board training. Committee membership and participation is expected of all Executive Board members, but your total commitment of time should not be more than 5 hours a month for Directors and a little bit more for Officers, unless you want to volunteer to do more.
