As you may be aware, the Governor last night extended the Bay Area's shelter-in-place order to the entire state to enhance social distancing measures in response to COVID-19.

The new statewide order continues to allow for essential businesses—such as banks, grocery stores, pharmacies, food banks and gas stations—to remain open. Restaurants can also remain open for delivery and pickup only. Bars are among the non-essential businesses that will close.

Our County of Marin Public Health Officer orders and operating parameters will remain operational and controlling unless otherwise clarified later today. County business will remain operational and consistent with this week's local operating parameters. If you had assignments on site, in the field, or working remotely/teleworking, please continue as planned.
